Please note the following which help us to maintain the beauty and character of Knollwood Memorial Park.

- Only fresh flowers are allowed and must be placed in bronze vase containers.
- Potted plants, baskets, balloons, flags, plantings, artificial flowers, displays, chimes or non-floral items are not allowed and will be removed.
- Funeral flowers will be removed within three days following the funeral.
- Memorial Day displays are not restricted, but will be removed seven days after the holiday.
- Flags and flag holders will be removed three days after the Memorial Day holiday.
- During the winter season displays such as winter baskets, logs and wreaths are allowed and will be removed by March 15.
- Due to potential damage to the vase by freezing water, the use of bronze vases are not allowed between November 15 through March 15.
